COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION GRANTS

The BCDA announced funding of \$25,000 in grants to existing businesses. The focus is on existing businesses and building owners. The application deadline is April 3rd, 2021.



BCDA SUPPORTS INDUSTRY EXPANSION OF BONNIE PLANTS



BCDA is collaborating with the Alabama Department of Commerce to support the current multi-million dollar expansion (January 2021) of warehouse and greenhouse space at Bonnie Plants in Bullock County. This will involve new local job creation.



BCDA UTILITY PARTNERS

The BCDA secured local utility partner's industry support grants, to the BCDA, totaling \$37,500 for the specific use of projects in technology and airport improvements in Bullock County. Participants in this endeavor were Union Springs Telephone, Dixie Electric, and Alabama Power.

The BCDA created a hotspot virtual learning zone (behind City Hall). The BCDA collaborated with the City of Union Springs and utilized the BCDA's utility partners Industry Support Grant. A password can be obtained by the student's school system or BCDA.
